

Cuckooshrikes – use a large amount of lichen in their nests for camouflage.



Friarbird nest (below)
Diameter 100mm (4") Depth 50mm (2")



Currawong on nest – Similar robust nest style as crow, though not as large.

Wren – Dome-shaped (with Canopy)
Diameter 90mm (3.5")
Depth 75mm (3")



Silvereeye nest –
Diam 50mm (2")
Depth 38mm (1.5")

width 500mm (20")
depth 250mm (10")
Bowl Dimensions
width 220mm (9")

Bowerbird Arena – Note this is the "Bachelor Pad" and NOT a nest. They nest in trees
